1. Call to order: Hailey Wong, at 6:35pm
2. Upcoming Events:
  - Movie Night: “The Incredibles” will be shown on Thurs, April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Ticket revenue will benefit the Grade 7 Grad fund, and Concession sales will go to the PAC.
  - Sports Day is Thurs, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018. An update will be given at the next PAC meeting.
3. Financial Updates:
  - Spring Scholastic Book Fair: took place on April 12-13, 2018, and was a great success. Over \$400.00 worth of books was acquired for the school library, and over \$1000.00 was raised for PAC.
  - PAC Fundraising Recap: as of April 13, 2018, \$19,000.00 has been raised.
  - Grade 7 Fundraising: as of April 13, 2018, Grade 7 Fundraisers (freezies sales, Kernals popcorn sales, movie night ticket sales, candygram sales, hot lunch sales) have raised over \$4000.00. Melissa Kan announced that after this month, no further Kernals popcorn sales would take place.

4. Other Business:

- Track and Field Jerseys update: 150 new Weir jerseys were ordered, and have arrived in time to distribute to this year's track and field team.
- Weir "spirit wear" T-shirts: PAC received almost 200 pre-orders for the Weir school t-shirts! The order will be placed this week, and will hopefully arrive before Sports Day. Extra shirts will be ordered, and will be available for sale on Sports Day.
- Weir PAC Scholarship for Killarney Graduates: A motion was made to continue to fund 2 scholarships of \$250.00 going to the top male and female student, totaling \$500.00. The recipients must have attended Weir school for a minimum of 4 years to qualify. The motion was passed unanimously.
- Gym Equipment: a wish list was submitted by Mr. Eves to purchase new equipment for the students (bocce sets, croquet sets, basketballs, foam balls). A vote on whether to approve funding for the equipment was held, and the funding was unanimously approved.

5. Updates from the Principal:

- Capital Project Proposal 5-year Submission was released. There is a July 31, 2018 deadline for the VSB to submit a proposal regarding Weir's seismic upgrading to the Ministry of Education.
- "The Most Magnificent Thing" school-wide project will kick-off at an assembly next Monday, April 23, 2018. This project will spur the imagination and encourage outside critical thinking. There will be an open house on Wed, May 2, 2018, from 5:00-7:00pm.
- Planning for the 2018-2019 school year: School numbers are due on Fri, April 20, 2018. By May 4, 2018, Principals will receive staffing numbers for next year.
- "Week of Dance"- students will be participating in a week of group dance lessons and will be performing their routines this Friday!
