1. Call to Order: Hailey Wong, 9:10am, Welcome
2. Book Fair Update: JoAnn Ng, Book Fair Chair
 - Scholastic Book Fair is scheduled for this week, with Preview Day on Wednesday, Feb. 5th, and Sales on Thursday, Feb. 6th and Friday, Feb. 7th. Thank you to all the parent volunteers who make Book Fair possible.
3. Financial Update: Marsella Lim, Treasurer
 - As of Tuesday, Feb. 4th, \$3215.00 has been raised through the Direct Drive campaign.
 - \$341.09 was raised in pre-orders and concession sales at the December 13, 2019 Movie Afternoon.
 - October 9-11, 2019 Book Fair raised \$1550.42 in Cash to PAC and Books to Weir students.
 - \$7017.35 has been raised so far through the Hot Lunch program.
 - Spirit Wear has raised \$1002.28 for PAC.

- Upcoming Fundraisers: Book Fair, Movie Night, Sports Day, and ongoing Hot Lunch program.

4. Spirit Wear:

- A mistake at the printer's resulted in the Weir logo being printed in red instead of white on the Spirit Wear.
- Students/Parents were offered a choice of taking their Spirit Wear printed in red, or waiting for Spirit Wear which was reprinted in the correct white ink.
- PAC purchased the remaining red printed stock and are offering them for sale through Munch-A-Lunch, under "Fundraising".

5. Old Business:

- Movie Afternoon - Dec. 13, 2019 - was very well received. 117 tickets were sold and raised \$234 for Grade 7 Camp and Grad Activities. Perhaps another Movie Afternoon is possible after the seismic move? MacCorkindale expressed interest in meeting with the PAC - possibly host events and invite MacCorkindale to join Weir students?
- Time Capsule: Chris Wong, District Principal, will research and gather information from other school communities about how they went about creating a Time Capsule, determining what size it could be, and what items would be put in.

6. New Business:

- Movie Night on Thursday, Feb. 13, 2020 is showing "Abominable" at 6:30pm. Pre-orders are accepted until Monday, Feb. 10, 2020. 40 orders have been placed so far.
- Memento for new Weir school: proposal to create a "WEIR" mural using the painted handprints of Weir students on the gym wall. The mural would be photographed and postcards and poster/canvas printed to commemorate the original Weir elementary school. The date for making the mural has yet to be decided, but will take place before Spring Break. Motion was put forward to approve the mural proposal and a budget of \$500 towards paint, rollers, printing costs, etc. Motion was approved.
- Treats Day: PAC sponsored popsicle treat day for the students before the seismic move. Budget of \$100 was approved.
- Parent Volunteers Needed at Seismic Swing Sites:
 - Fruit and Vegetable Program: F/V Coordinator can still continue this program and deliver fruit and veggies to the 3 swing sites. Ms. Gascoigne will ask other schools about availability of fridge space for milk and fruit and veggie storage. The PAC fridge will be moved to Killarney Secondary

swing site and can be used for the F/V program for grade 6-7s. Parent volunteers will be needed.

- Hot Lunch: in order to continue this very popular program at all 3 swing sites, parent volunteers will be needed. Please help out if you can.

7. Upcoming Events:

- Seismic Busing Meeting - Tuesday, Feb. 6th, 6:30pm-7:30pm in the Gym.
- Spring Concert - Wednesday, Feb. 19th, 7:00pm-8:00pm in the Gym. As this concert involves fewer classes than the Winter Concert, no tickets for admission will be needed.
