5. Call for Volunteers for 2023-2024 PAC Executive & Committee Team

Why does Weir need a PAC (Parent Advisory Committee)?

- a. Acts as liaison between parents & the school's administrators. We organize social events, advocate for students' needs & raise money to fund school programs and equipment.
- b. Eligible for the annual gaming grant of \$20 each enrolling student
 - i. Grant is intended to benefit BC students through the enhancement of extracurricular opportunities & community involvement
 - ii. Example: 370 students = \$7200 per year of additional non-curriculum funding (school clubs, subsidize field trips, school celebrations, school-wide art projects, etc ...)
- c. To continue the running of Fruit & Veggie + Dairy program
- d. To continue our school's highly popular hot lunch fundraising program
- e. To continue providing classroom & resource teachers with additional classroom funding
 - i. \$250 per class / \$125 per resource teacher
- f. To provide funding to the following needs:
 - i. Primary and Intermediate playgrounds
 - ii. New library books (book fair/book exchange event)
 - iii. Music instruments
 - iv. Sports equipment
 - v. Technology (iPads)

6. Principal/Vice-Principal Remarks

- Core Competencies: Communication, Thinking, Personal & Social
 - everything in the curriculum falls under these concepts
 - next year there will be 3 self-assessments in the report cards done by students (teachers do not assess)
 - School Vision 2023-2024:
 - The MDI (Middle Years Development Instrument): an online assessment that grade 6 students completed earlier this fall; gives lots of information to the school to build goals for the school plan
 - UBC collates the results
 - Some results: Safe adults that kids trust (2 or more): 72% at Weir
 - Many students at Weir are spending time online, more than district average
 - Overall, students at Weir feel very safe and connected to the school, but not feeling a sense of belonging as much (maybe due to timing of survey)
- VP role cut next year (any school enrollment under 400 does not receive a VP)
 - Nicole will return to classroom (resource)
- Increase of resource time for next school year: 1.3 FTE (2 postings)
- Hiring a specialist music teacher for next year; no more highschool teacher to teach intermediate students because Elementary union voted against it
- Year-end concert on June 28, possibly at Killarney auditorium
