## Principal's Report

- School has ordered 30 iPads, 30 colour coded cases to keep them in different parts of the school,
- Purchased 3 flat screen TVs (65 inch) and stands
- TVs much more versatile than the projector \& smart boards; easy to move around
- Projectors are labour-intensive process to maintain (bulbs are $\$ 100$ each, 19 different bulbs too much hassle)
- Purchase of volleyball nets: instead of getting 2 smaller nets, staff have decided to buy 1 long net that runs the length of the gym with 2 supporting posts in the middle; same cost
- NED presentation next week: Growth Mindset - a yoyo based presentation
- 2 small mini Winter concerts with sing-along
- Gaza fundraiser \$1131 raised which will be matched; all donations to Red Cross
- Learning Updates (report cards) will be sent home Dec. $1^{\text {st }}$ to families

Update from Alex re: iPads Purchase:

- We can now purchase iPads through the Gaming Grant as we will have extracurricular clubs to teach ADST apps such as Scratch (coding), Pro Create (graphic design) and possibly other apps

- Gloria Terry - might be interested in being the coordinator for t-shirt sales
